



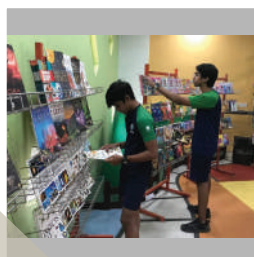

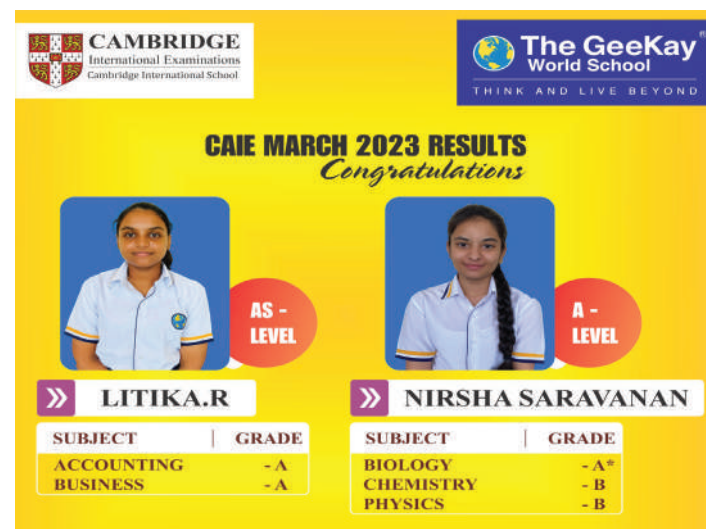

New Computer Lab @ TGWS

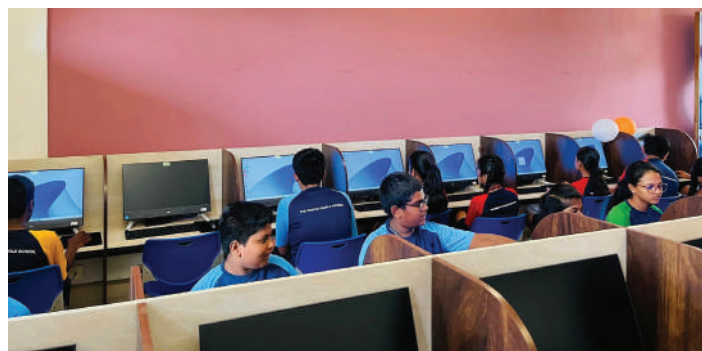
TGWS adds another Hi-Tech Computer Lab

International Yoga Day

On the 21st of June 2023, TGWS celebrated International Yoga Day to mark the relevance of this ancient practice to promote health and well-being. We started this occasion with a special assembly to practice Yoga in our assembly hall, with the hall filled with students and teachers as participants in the event. This assembly was planned and executed by our Sports Team, with the presentation from our Grade 11 students.

The importance of Yoga was highlighted by our students, providing us with some valuable information about this ancient practice. The how, when, where, and why of the entire practice were explained by our students. There was a live demo cum presentation of yoga by the Isha Yoga Team, demonstrating a few vital asanas which can be practiced by children. Isha volunteers taught 'Nadi Suddhi' and 'Yoga Namaskar' in a step-by-step way which our students joyfully learnt. The regular practice of some of these asanas can add more flexibility, muscular reinforcement to our body, the strengthening skeletal muscles and the nervous system, as in today's time the lack of proper exercise on a daily basis is a huge drawback to us humans in terms of physical and mental health.

Yoga also reminds us to take some time for ourselves in this busy world with our busy lives and practice what's vital for our health, because a healthy body and mind is what makes a healthy and balanced human being. Our Head of School, Mr. Ram Kumar addressed the entire audience with his encouraging words, shedding more light on the significance of the occasion. He then handed over souvenirs to the representatives of the Isha Foundation. The event concluded with our school song and National anthem.



Professional Development 23-24

Professional development is the institution's mission to empower educators with the information and skills to help them execute their work. TGWS had its PD session for the academic year 2023-24 from 29.5.23 to 6.6.23

In the opening session, the Head of School, Mr. Ram Kumar shed light on the best Teaching Practices and the joy of Teaching & learning. He appealed to the teachers to update their understanding of the subject in light of recent advancements in the field, to update their abilities, and aptitudes thereby creating new teaching methodologies with specific objectives. He also discussed the various ways by which TGWS can create children who stand out in society with a TGWS benchmark of competency and leadership. He elaborated "What the school expects from a Teacher?", "What the student expects from a teacher?" and "What are the parent's expectations?" In the second session, Mr. Senthil shed light on the GROW MODEL, which emphasized the need for a teacher to be a change-maker for a student. A teacher who lacks ambition is like a bird flying aimlessly, and it is necessary to set realistic goals, plan for goal setting, and determine whether we have met our objectives, as well as identify each teacher's strengths.

Another session threw light on The correction pattern of students' work by Ms. Mujeeba. "What exactly do you mean by correction?" in the teaching-learning process? Types of Correction, Challenges for Teachers, Strategies for inspecting notebooks in the classroom and the like were exhaustively discussed.

EMOTIONAL & SOCIAL INTELLIGENCE was another topic dealt with during the session and it began



with a team activity focusing on social emotion support for learning and five competencies to guide the students - Self-awareness, relationship skills, social awareness, self-management, responsible decision-making, Handling slow learners and Inquiry-based learning were also discussed in this session by Ms. Logapriya. TGWS always stands unique with its School Etiquette, Roles, and responsibilities of Teachers and the same was addressed to the new and existing teachers oriented by Ms. Merline, Ms. Muthu and Mr. Boopathy.

Another distinguishing feature of our school is that academics are integrated with life skills such as Visual and performing arts. Teachers handling PA & VA emphasized the need for these skills and how they help children learn subjects better through appropriate integration through a number of engaging activities.

Sports Activities, which operate parallel to academics and are equally vital to all children, were briefed to all teachers by the sports HOD, Mr. Manigandan with some interesting physical activities.

The importance of English communication to teachers as well as students was brought alive by Ms. Sharon, English Facilitator through a variety of activities and questionnaires to help them understand the school system. We had reflection sessions everyday evening where teachers shared their learning experiences led by Ms. Preethi and Ms. Rachel. The valedictory of this year's PD session was conducted on 6.6.23 where teachers reflected on their takeaways from every session. On the whole, the PD sessions enabled Teachers to get a first-hand understanding of the various aspects of teaching. It also motivated them to develop and apply new strategies to make the teaching-learning process more effective and meaningful.

School Tour

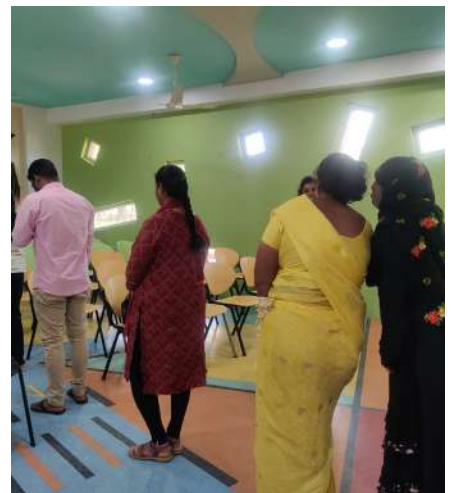
