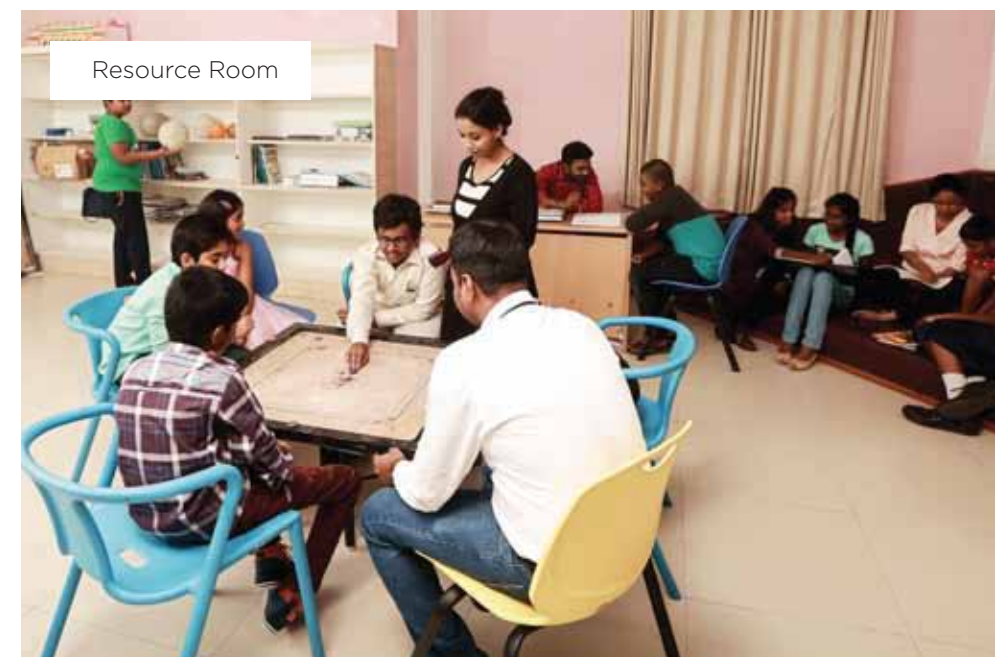




# REASSURING PARENTS OF ALL ESSENTIALS OF LIFE FOR THEIR CHILDREN

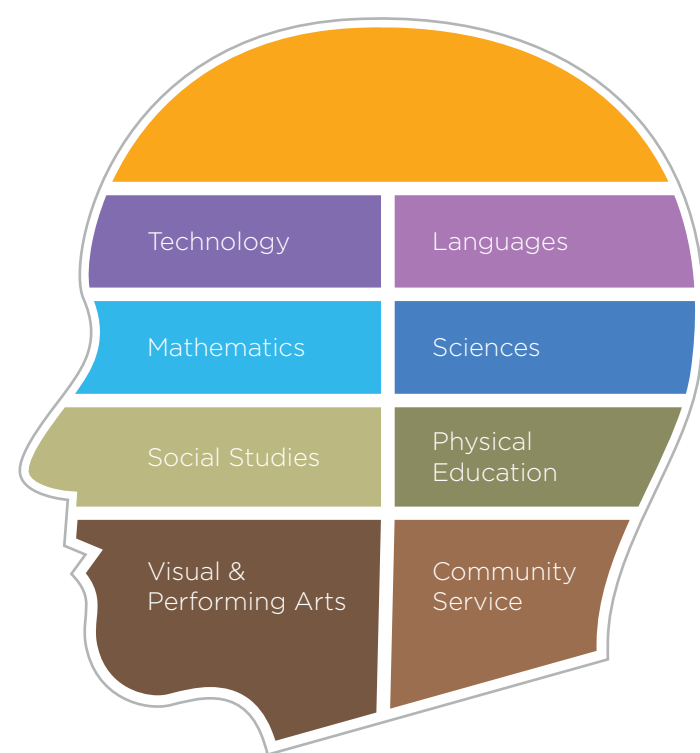

- Technology

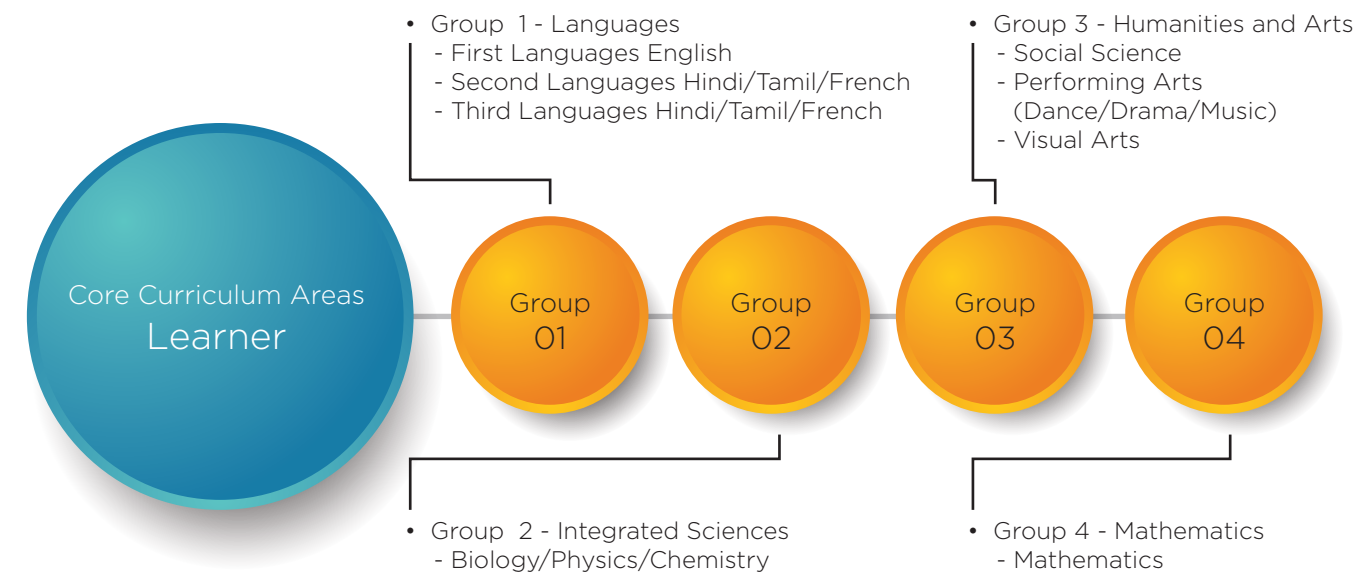
### GIPI Assessments at Primary

### Higher Secondary at TGWS

The Higher Secondary at TGWS follows the Cambridge AS/A Level Programme and CBSE-AISSCE programme.

#### Cambridge AS/A Level

The Cambridge International AS/A level at TGWS prepares the students for English Language(AS Level) and the following subjects at both AS and A Level: Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Business Management, Psychology, Accounting, Applied ICT

#### AISSCE (CBSE)

The AISSCE Programme at TGWS prepares students for Science, Commerce and Humanities Stream. Some of the subjects are: English, Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Computer Science and Informatics Practices.
