PTM

Primary

IGCSE - Field Trip

On 14th August, 2023, students of G10 IGCSE and A-level went on a field trip to Kanchanagiri Hills to learn about the practical application of constructing quadrats in ecological research. Quadrats are essential tools used in sampling and studying ecosystems, aiding in the assessment of biodiversity, population density, and species distribution. Their objective was to understand the significance of quadrats in ecological studies and to gain hands-on experience in constructing and using them. The field trip began with an informative session led by Ms. Priya (Biology facilitator), introducing the concept of quadrats. After the introduction, students were divided into two groups. Each group proceeded to construct their own quadrats. They were provided with ropes and measuring scales. Each quadrat had



dimensions to suit the study area's requirements. Students carefully measured and marked the corners of the quadrat to ensure an accurate representation of the chosen area. Once the quadrats were positioned, they identified and recorded all plant species within each quadrat, noting their abundance, height, and other relevant observations. Additionally, they also collected data on soil characteristics, such as moisture content and pH, to understand their influence on plant distribution.

The field trip about constructing quadrats was an enlightening experience that provided students with practical insights into ecological research techniques. Through hands-on construction and placement of quadrats, they gained a deeper understanding of their significance in assessing biodiversity and studying ecosystem dynamics. This field trip underscored the importance of systematic sampling and data collection in ecological studies, equipping them with valuable skills for future scientific endeavors.

Chess Competition

What is mathematics?

You might have asked yourself what mathematics actually is and why it is so different from the other disciplines. "Mathematics is the discipline studying quantities, forms, and the relationships between them." This is the standard dictionary definition, but it does not satisfy us as either students, teachers or researchers because surely you have felt that mathematics means more than that.

Searching on the internet, you will find various definitions, some of them beautiful from a literary-stylistic point of view, or with great philosophical substance, but certainly you will not find a definition that reflects the nature of mathematics in its entire complexity. Here is the list of my top favorite such definitions are:

"Mathematics is ..."

"Mathematics is the music of reason." (Paul Lockhart)

"Mathematics is the poetry of the universe." (Jonathan David Farley)

"Mathematics is the queen of the sciences." (Carl Friedrich Gauss)

"An equation means nothing to me unless it expresses a thought of God." (Srinivasa Ramanujan)

According to me.....

'Mathematics is not only a discipline, a method, and a language, applicable to other disciplines or methods of knowledge, but also to mathematics itself. It is a mode of organizing, validating, and communicating knowledge, which uses the principles of logic and gives it a field of manifestation and application that is "pure," free from contingency, and free from the confusion of natural language, in which the truths of propositions are universally valid and do not depend on any interpretation. It is not only a discipline entitled to

investigate concepts of any nature and any degree of generality, but also is self-referential and self-applicable.

Falling to bits!!!


Grouped together




